Ms. Thompson reports:

Pre-K students are learning ways to help keep our environment clean and safe through the Reduce, Reuse, and Recycle unit. Students walked around the school to look for trash and clean up. They talked about how the trash got there and what should have been done with the trash. They created a KWL chart about Recycling. Students looked at different items and then discussed how they could be reused. In small groups, they made bird feeders out of their milk cartons collected at lunch.
